On Sep 24, 1949, Beulah married Burnell Ramsey, a union that lasted over 50 years; and they were blessed with nine children. She was a loving wife and mother; whose greatest pride was in taking care of her family. While directing their children toward educational pursuits, she supported the career of her husband, as he became the first Black Sheriff of Copiah County. Together, they worked for the security and education of their children; and proudly, eight of the nine children attended college. In addition, she worked at Sanderson Farms for over 22 years, and later as a Private Sitter at Pinecrest Nursing Home - allowing her to help family and others achieve their dreams.

Faith and Service were always important in Beulah's life. At an early age, she accepted Christ and demonstrated her faith in how she raised their children in Godly living. She kept them active in church activities; and after they were older, she resumed her participation and service in the church of her youth, Antioch Missionary Baptist Church. She also practiced her gift of service by participating in Women's Social Clubs, and volunteering for worthwhile and benevolent causes. Beulah was always available and willing to help those in need – especially family and close friends. Service was her love language, and a reflection of the God she loved and served. She lived these values, and lovingly instilled them in her children and grandchildren.

In addition to her parents (Fred and Mary Banks); her husband (Burnell Ramsey Sr.), three children (Gerald, Cynthia & Gloria), and all five siblings (Walter Lee Banks, John Henry Banks, James Banks, Josie Mae Jones, and Fred Banks Jr.) have gone home before her. They were all blessed with her gifts of love and kindness.

Beulah will be missed but treasured in the hearts of many, especially those she leaves behind - including six children - Argie Macklin, Burnell Ramsey Jr. (Loryene), James Ramsey Sr. (Lorna), Angelia Coleman (Kenneth), Kenneth Ramsey Sr. (Gretel), and Cosandra Daniels (John Pearl); one sister-in-law, Minnie Banks, 22 Grandchildren, 38 Great-grandchildren, and a host of cousins, nieces, nephews, and friends.
